
LEAGUE COMMUNICATION

CODE OF CONDUCT

Manchester Little League has an established Code of Conduct Policy for all Managers, Coaches, Umpires, Players, Parents and Spectators.

Various types of infractions can result in suspensions from our Little League Complex after a complete investigation by our Zero Tolerance Committee has been completed.

The policy is posted on the league website.

We, the Manchester Little League, 7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices

We, the Nanchester Little League, have implemented the following Sport Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league.

Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and be suspended from the following game. Repeat violations may cause a multiple game and resion, or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games.

Preamble

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles:

- · Trustworthiness.
- · Respect,
- * Responsibility,
- · Fairness,
- Caring, and
- Good Citizenship.

The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character."

I therefore agrees

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- 5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
- 6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.

- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the athletes.
- I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- 10. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
- 14. I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- 15. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 16. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- 17. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

MANCHESTER LITTLE LEAGUE ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Manchester Little League has a Zero Tolerance Policy for all managers, coaches, umpires, players, parents, family, and spectators. This policy helps ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable experience at games, practices, and other league events. Anyone determined by Manchester Little League's Zero Tolerance Committee to have violated the Zero Tolerance Policy while at the Manchester Little League complex or any game, practice, or league event will be subject to disciplinary action that may, based upon the Committee's consideration of the facts and seriousness of the violation, include suspension from the complex and all league activities for up to a year. In addition to the suspension, a person who violates the Zero Tolerance Policy may be required to funite activitions, such as attending an anger management program, before being considered for reinstatement.

Knowingly engaging in actions such as the following may be determined to be a violation of the Zero Tolerance Policy: 1. Any physical assault on any other person. 2. Possession or being under the influence of alcohol or any illegal drug. 3. Sexual harassment, sexual behavior, lewdness, use of vulgar language, or any action or behavior that may reasonably be characterized as sexual in nature. 4. Theft or destruction of money or property of the league or any other person. 5. Possession of a firearm or weapon (except for duly authorized law enforcement and emergency personnel). 6. Unabated verbal abuse, harassment, threats, baiting, "trash talking," or inciting abuse or disrespect of players, managers, coaches, umpires, or other spectators. 7. Entering the playing field to intentionally disrupt any game or practice or without the authorization of an umpire, manager, or coach. 8. Knowingly allowing a player to play while injured or creating an unsafe playing condition for any player. 9. Any other conduct or action that can be characterized as harassment, bullying, or in violation of the law or any municipal ordinance. This policy is in addition to Manchester Little League's Code of Conduct, and any conduct or action determined to be in violation of the Code of Conduct that does not rise to the level of a violation of the Zero Tolerance Policy may be punished as provided in the Manchester Little League by-laws.

Manchester Little League will report any criminal conduct to the police. I acknowledge that I have read and understand this Zero Tolerance Policy and that I and my child will be subject to disciplinary action if determined to have violated it.

RESIDENCY DOCS

MANDATED BY WILLIAMSPORT

Each parent in our league, at ALL levels, need to supply their coach with COPIES of three (3) proofs of residency for each child **OR** a completed School Enrollment Form.

Examples of Proof of Residency are ONE DOC from each Group below;

<u>GROUP ONE</u> - Driver's License / School records / Vehicle records / Employment records / Insurance documents

<u>GROUP TW</u>O - Welfare / child-care records / Federal records / State records / Local records / Support payment records / Homeowner or tenant records / Military records.

<u>GROUP THREE</u> - Voter's Registration - Utility bills / Financial records / Medical records / Internet, cable, or satellite records

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: A Williamsport rule states that the residency docs you provide to your goach must be dated between February 1st, 2023 & February 1st, 2024


